This course aims to explore the world of the professional and keen amateur musician who presents with upper limb disorders. We will explore the world of the musician, how problems present, assessment approaches and core hand therapy skills which can be deployed. Extended scope skills in management of the psychological effects of pain, threat to play and loss of self will be examined. Entering the world of an elite musician is both terrifying and a privilege and we will explore together how to make this deeply professionally satisfying caseload to work with.

Webinar 1: Introduction to hand therapy for musicians

This webinar will include a summary of musculoskeletal problems presenting in musicians, risk factors, common disorders, assessment, specific outcome measures, the role of prevention rather than cure (including evidence) and prevention strategies.

Referentin: Nicola Goldsmith, MSc Dip COT SROT

Nicola has been a specialist occupational therapist in hand therapy since 1991 having worked in both the NHS and private sectors. She always maintained a clinical caseload but much of her experience has involved developing hand therapy departments across the private sector in the UK. Nicola worked as the clinical director of GripAble for three years, is Past President of the International Federation of Societies for Hand Therapy and is now the Clinical Ambassador for Performance Health. Nicola teaches as a partner in NES Hand Therapy Training, which has been operating for over 25



years and independently in many universities in Portugal. Clinically, Nicola sees patients for about 20 hours per week and approximately 70% of her caseload involves working with musicians. She has recently run a course on injury awareness and prevention at the Royal Academy of Music.
